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CATEGORIES

Residential

Singular Space [any residential singular space such as an entry, living room, kitchen, bathroom, master suite, bedroom, rec room, exercise room, etc.]

Under 3,500 Square Feet [multiple spaces from a residence; a minimum of three spaces must be featured]

Over 3,500 Square Feet [multiple spaces from a residence; a minimum of three spaces must be featured]

Contract

Corporate [environments in which people work, including offices, businesses, lobbies, conference rooms, financial and government institutions, child care, educational, religious, correctional and recreational facilities, fire and police stations, courts, embassies, libraries, auditoriums, museums, transportation by land, air, or sea, etc.]

Healthcare [environments in which people receive care such as hospitals, clinics, examination rooms, surgical suites, mobile units, hospice care homes, nursing, assisted living or long term care facilities, etc.]

Hospitality [environments that entertain or host the public, including nightclubs, restaurants, theaters, hotels, city and country clubs, golf facilities, conference facilities, transportation by land, air, or sea, etc.]

Retail [environments that concentrate on retail venues, including boutiques, department stores, outlets, showrooms, food retailing centers, shopping malls, etc.]

Green Design

[sustainable design that is concerned with the environmental/ecological, economic, ethical and social aspects and impacts of design; it involves the use of design and construction methods and materials that will not compromise the health of the environment or the health and welfare of the occupants of a space]

Universal Design

[a space(s) that exemplifies various aspects of "universal design," including the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), accessibility and "barrier-free" design, or design for an aging population]

Product, Furniture, or Design Detail

[including, but not limited to custom designs of case goods and built-ins, upholstery, window treatments, architectural details]

Student Project

[any residential or contract project that demonstrates the student's understanding of interior space and creative solutions; design concept, programming, analysis, space planning, drawings, renderings, materials, etc. are encouraged]

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ELIGIBILITY

Only current members of the NE/IA ASID Chapter may enter the competition, whether they are entering as individual designers or members of a design team. Each entry must represent an installation completed after January 1, 2008, with the exception of re-submittals. A project that has been submitted, but has not previously won a Chapter Award, may be resubmitted for up to three years. Projects receiving prior publicity to the 2010 NE/IA ASID Project Awards are eligible. Entrants may submit as many projects as desired; **however, each project may only be submitted in one category.** [EXCEPTION TO THE RULE: The Product, Furniture, or Design Detail category may feature an element from a project that has been submitted to another category; however, different photos must accompany the entry.] If it appears as if one project has been entered in multiple categories, the designer responsible will be asked to choose the most applicable category. As a reminder, entry fees will not be refunded.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Please enter projects in the most applicable category. Entries must include, but are not limited to, a concept statement, reduced floor plans, and a minimum of four color prints (5x7 or larger). Only entrants in the Product, Furniture, or Design Detail category may submit less than four prints. Finish samples, color swatches, and fabric samples are optional, but encouraged.

JUDGING

A judging panel consisting of members from another ASID Chapter will meet no later than July 2010 to judge submittals. The criteria for evaluation will be based on the elements and principles of design through the following categories: design concept, scale and proportion, unity and variety, emphasis, balance and rhythm, color composition, effectiveness of space planning, relationship of materials, textures and patterns, appropriate design solution, submittal presentation. The judging panel shall reserve the right to withhold an award if, in their opinion, the nominations do not meet the criteria. As a reminder, no two entries are compared to one another... each project will be judged on its own merit.

PRESENTATION

Awards will be presented at the NE/IA ASID Chapter Awards Banquet on Thursday, September 30, 2010.

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ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Interested participants must provide all current contact information on the Entry Application form, including an email address. Completed Entry Application form with \$60.00 (\$20 – ASID Student Members) registration fee per entry must be sent via Certified Mail and received by the Project Awards Chairmen no later than Monday, April 19, 2010. **LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** Upon receipt of the Entry Application Form and registration fee, instructions for preparation of entries will be **EMAILED** to participating designers and binders will be distributed. Binder submissions must be received by 5:00 p.m., Monday, June 7, 2010. **LATE BINDERS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

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
